### Eligibility for Preservation Awards

- Any individual, organization, or project involved in historic preservation is eligible to receive a Preservation Award
- Nominated projects must be completed within the past 5 years
- Projects recognized in Private Preservation and Commercial Revitalization categories must conform to the Secretary of Interior Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.
- Previous award recipients are eligible for nomination for a different project (except where noted)
- Nominations may be made without the knowledge of the nominee

## **Commercial Revitalization through Historic Preservation Award**

This award recognizes excellence in commercial or industrial revitalization through the use of historic preservation in the rehabilitation or adaptive reuse of an existing structure. This award may also be given to recognize outstanding new infill construction that adapts scale, architectural features, and materials from neighboring buildings and incorporates them in the construction. Secretary of Interior Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties shall apply.

## **Private Preservation**

This award recognizes excellence for private preservation projects, substantial changes towards more original features or appearance through the application of the Secretary of Interior Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with emphasis on restoration.

This award recognizes efforts by an individual or organization for positive efforts impacting neighborhood stabilization and/or revitalization. Secretary of Interior Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties shall apply.
